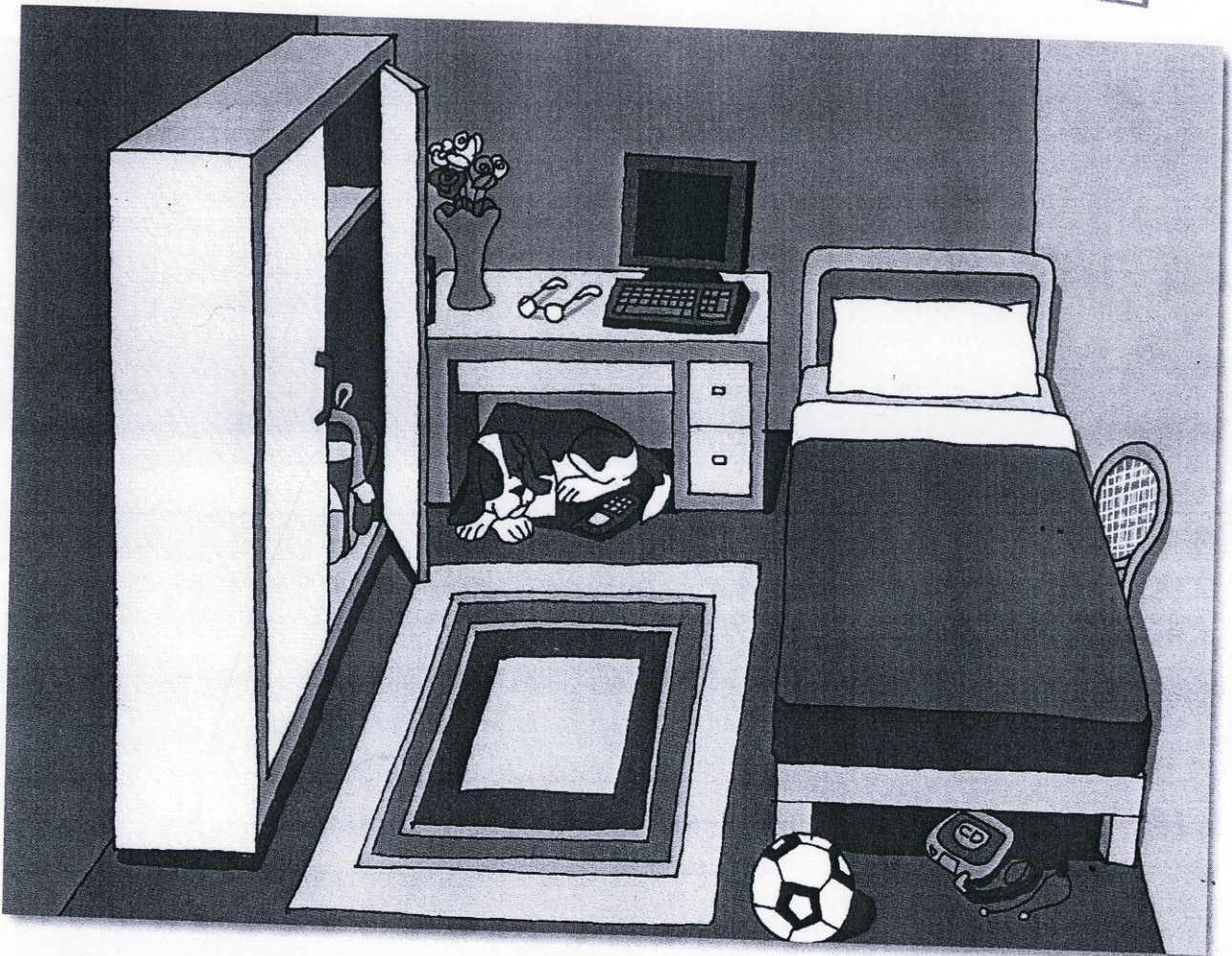




My favorite room
